The 2025 October meeting was held on October 14, 2025, at the Wright-Waldron Municipal Building. President Shawn Barnhart called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. All stood to recite the Pledge of Allegiance and roll call was taken with Trustees Emil Gravelle, Allison Harwood, Stacie Shamplo and President Shawn Barnhart present, and trustee Brian Bernath absent.

#### Public Comment

None.

Allison Harwood made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of 105 & 107 East Street. Emil Gravelle supported the motion, and it carried with a voice vote.

Emil Gravelle made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of September 9, 2025. Allison Harwood supported, and it carried with a voice vote.

Allison Harwood made a motion to approve the special meeting minutes of September 18, 2025. Stacie Shamplo supported, and it carried with a voice vote.

#### Reports to Council

County Commissioner Brent Leininger updated the board regarding the following: millage changes, Boyd Drain, changes in payments received by the State.

Trustee Allison Harwood reported for Fire Board. They received 21 medical calls, 2 fire calls, 1 crash, and 4 fire assist, for a total of 28 calls in the month of September.

Street Administrator Shawn Barnhart reported for maintenance. They have been working on weekly brush pickup, mowing, and the lagoons. The blowout on S. Mackinaw is not a blowout, but a rodent in a hole. The tires have been replaced on the black truck, along with an alignment and replacement of a tie rod. The leaf blower is up and running and they are ready to start once leaves are ready.

Street Administrator Shawn Barnhart reported the project for the Dollar General is complete and is under budget. Also, they will be posting a sign at the post office parking area.

The written report for the water and sewer systems was reviewed.

The written utility billing report was reviewed.

The written code enforcement report was reviewed. Alternate methods of delivering notices were discussed.

Emil Gravelle reported for the Planning & Zoning Commission. Their next meeting is scheduled for November 5<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm.

Allison Harwood reported that she had planted the flowers.

Treasurer Bill Hall presented his report. \$15,036.80 outstanding on the taxes.

Clerk Casey Gravelle reported on the banking move, an update on the software move, and July and August minutes omitted the approval of the agendas. Discussion followed.

Emil Gravelle moved that there was an inadvertent error in the minutes of July and August 2025 and the agendas had been approved. Allison Harwood supported and it carried with a voice vote.

President Shawn Barnhart reported the Birdsell's will start demo on their house by the end of the month and Tillman will begin the siding work on the Municipal Building soon.
